Wander through our living room and see all the books **FOR SALE BY DONATION**. You might just find your next reading treasure.

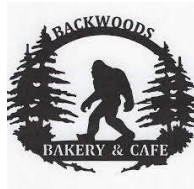


Books2Eat... *With A Twist*

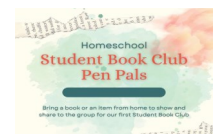
Homeschool Student Book Club Pen Pals
