On display May 27th through till the middle of June.



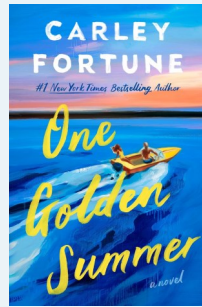
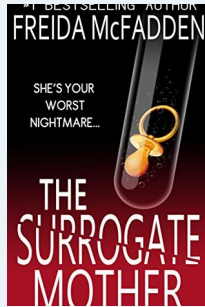

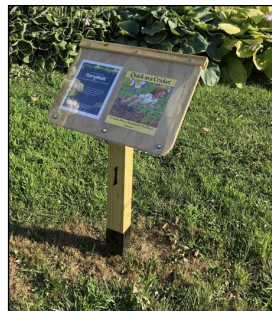
